

**REGULAR SESSION
SECOND DAY**

The Chairman called the Board to order, the roll was called and the following Representatives were found to be present:

Relic, Feldstein, Henderson, Fournier, Durkin, Iversen, Lindberg, McCarty, Schwerd, Stayton, Rothenberger, Laguna, Hodne.

Under Privilege of the Floor, Daniel Stannard, Worcester, asked the County Board to help get state legislation adopted that would require the following items to have a \$25.00 deposit, exchange or voucher applied to it at the time of purchase: computers, microwaves, televisions, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, gas stoves, electric stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, mattresses, box springs, car batteries and living room suits. There would be no expiration date on these deposits or vouchers. He said that a lot of these items are being dumped on the back roads, in ravines, in streams and on hill sides. Something needs to be done about the matter.

The reports of the Standing Committees were given and ordered filed.

Representative Feldstein moved for an executive session to discuss a personnel matter. Seconded, Laguna. Total: 6,167; Ayes: 5,672; Absent: 495 – Powers. Motion carried.

The Board reconvened.
