The Otsego County Department of Health is offering an H1N1 Influenza (Flu) Nasal Spray to healthy persons (no underlying medical conditions) ages 2 – 24 years of age. It is **extremely important** to note that the H1N1 Influenza (Flu) Nasal Spray **CAN NOT** be administered to the following persons.

- Pregnant persons
- Persons less than 2 years of age
- Persons greater than or equal to 50 years of age
- If you received another live virus vaccine in the last 28 days.
- Allergy to eggs, a component of the vaccine or anaphylactic allergy to latex
- Adults and children who have chronic pulmonary (including asthma, or an episode of wheezing in the last 12 months), cardiovascular (except hypertension), renal, hepatic, neurological/neuromuscular, hematological, or metabolic disorders (including diabetes mellitus);
- Adults and children who have immunosuppression (including immunosuppression caused by medications or by HIV);
- Children or adolescents aged 2–18 years receiving aspirin or other salicylates (because of the association of Reye syndrome with wild-type influenza virus infection);

H1N1 FLU MIST Vaccination Clinic

The H1N1 Flu Mist can only be given to the following persons:

- Healthy persons (no underlying medical conditions) age 2 to 24 years
