

OTSEGO COUNTY IS PARTNERING WITH TRIAD MATTRESS RECYCLING TO REMOVE MATTRESSES FROM OUR WASTE STREAM.

BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 1, 2016, MATTRESSES AND BOXSPRINGS WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE COUNTY'S WASTE STREAM AND RECYCLED THROUGH A PARTNERSHIP WITH TRIAD RECYCLING AND ENERGY OF TONAWANDA, NY. RECYCLING OF MATTRESSES AND BOXSPRINGS WILL ELIMINATE DISPOSING OF REUSABLE MATERIAL INTO LANDFILLS. THE INFORMATION BELOW PROVIDES DETAILS ON THE IMPACT OF RECYCLING MATTRESSES AND BOXSPRINGS. - ❖ Servicing S. Ontario, Buffalo, Niagara Falls, Rochester, Jamestown to Syracuse, Binghamton, Elmira, Watertown, Utica, Troy, Albany and NYC
- ❖ Ability to recycle mattresses from anywhere in North America
- ❖ Mattress recycling conserves resources. Recycling just 25% of mattresses and box springs annually disposed of in the US would conserve:
 - 103,370 tons of steel
 - 37,500 tons of polyurethane foam
 - 55,013 tons of wood,
 - 1,183 million sq. feet of ticking
 - 335 million sq. feet of batting
 - 18,208.00 cubic yards of landfill space, assuming 66% compression rate
 - 2,500 lbs of iron ore for every ton of steel recycled
 - 1,400 lbs of coal and 120 lbs of limestone
