Representative Marietta gave a brief summary of the meeting, mentioning looking at other components such as technology related issues and Planning with Hank Schecher, guest speakers (Matthew Quick and Laura Mondo) and Brian Pokorny to discuss technology and how to better position the committee to have some bigger picture discussions around the use of technology and revisit work plans.

Matthew Quick from Eagleview, gave a presentation related to the capture process of oblique aerial imagery including but not limited to the following: Overview of Eagleview, Methodology, Key Government Applications, Multiple Business Partners and Integration, Desktop Accessible Web-Based Solution (CONNECTExplorer) and Assessment Solutions. Pictometry increases productivity and decreases expenses at the same time.

Laura Mondo, Regional Technical Manager of Eagleview, gave a brief demonstration of CONNECTExplorer and the imagery.

Representative Marietta mentioned that continued discussion on pricing and more information with other departments is needed, as the information has been beneficial and invaluable. Representative Marietta suggested to briefly introduce fundamental infrastructure areas of technology that need to be

addressed and better documented to start building the prioritization outline for technology at the April Board Meeting.

Representative Marietta mentioned that work plan efforts are still a work in process.
