Representative Kennedy explained that the purpose of this meeting is to discuss the appointment for the District 6 candidate as brought forward by the Democratic Committee, Diane Adesso, adding that there is also now a Libertarian candidate as well, Andrew Hamill and is not sure whether Mr. Hamill will be available to join the meeting or not.

Representative Kennedy moved for an executive session to discuss the appointment or employment of a particular person(s) at 9:08 a.m. Seconded, Frazier. Total: 2,721; Ayes: 2,187; Vacant: 534- District 6. Motion carried.

Representative Kennedy moved to come out of executive session at 9:39 a.m. Seconded, Martini. Total: 2,721; Ayes: 1,797; Absent: 390-Marietta; Vacant: 534- District 6. Motion carried.

Representative Kennedy explained that they were unsuccessful in contacting Mr. Hamill.

Representative Martini stated that at this point given the committee has already put forth a candidate and that the district is mostly a republican district that it seems like the wisest course of action would be to move forward with the nomination as it stands.
