SOLID WASTE –KAREN SULLIVAN, LONNIE O’BRYAN (CASELLA)

Karen Sullivan stated that due to global market changes the county is now getting charged to dispose of recyclables verses in the past the County received a rebate when disposing recyclables. Mrs. Sullivan stated that resolution #361-20171206 establishing a fee schedule needs to be changed to allow the transfer stations to charge a fee of \$55.00/ton or the market rate for commercial deliveries of recyclables. Mrs. Sullivan noted that resident recyclables will continue to be free, just commercial haulers will be charged the new fee. Mrs. Sullivan recommended that the new fee be effective June 1st which would give the haulers a grace period of one month. Mrs. Sullivan added that the transition period between getting a rebate on the disposal of recyclables to it now being a county expense to dispose of recyclables, including the grace period, was not budgeted for in 2018.

Representative Lapin and Farwell arrived during the above discussion.

Representative Koutnik moved to amend resolution 361-20171206 to add a fee of \$55.00/ton or the market rate based on the yellow sheet, to commercial haulers to dispose of their recyclables at the NTS and STS effective June 1st. Seconded, Kennedy. Total: 2,201; Ayes: 2,201. Motion carried.

There being no further business to discuss, the committee adjourned.
