COUNTY OF OTSEGO, NEW YORK

A LOCAL LAW INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE
CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AND
COUNTY AUDITOR OF OTSEGO COUNTY

Be it enacted by the board of supervisors of the County of Otsego as follows:

Section 1. The salary of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and County Auditor of the County of Otsego shall be Five Thousand Five Hundred Dollars per year payable in equal monthly installments.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect January 6, 1954.
