

**LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1966  
COUNTY OF OTSEGO, NEW YORK**

**A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR A SYSTEM OF WEIGHTED  
VOTING BY MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
REPRESENTING THE VARIOUS SUPERVISORY DISTRICTS  
IN THE COUNTY OF OTSEGO**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Otsego as follows:

**Section 1.** That the weight or quality of the vote of each supervisor representing the various supervisory districts in the County of Otsego shall be as follows.

**Section 2.** The total weight of all votes cast by the members of the Board of Supervisors when all are present shall be 270.

**Section 3.** The vote of each member of a standing or special committee of the Board of Supervisors shall carry the same weight as set forth in Section 1 above.

**Section 4.** This local law shall be subject to approval by referendum by the voters of Otsego County, and, if so approved, shall take effect on January 1, 1967.
