



LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 1988

A LOCAL LAW PERMITTING MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICE BOARD, OR ITS SUB-COMMITTEES, TO SERVE FOR MORE THAN TWO TERMS CONSECUTIVELY

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Representatives of the County of Otsego as follows:

1. Pursuant to the enabling statute, Section 41.11 of the Mental Hygiene Law, the Otsego County Board of Representatives does hereby authorize and permit a member of the Community Service Board, or any of its sub-committees, to serve for more than two terms consecutively.

2. This local law shall take effect forty-five (45) days after it shall have been adopted and certified copies thereof have been filed as required by Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

3. This local law shall be effective as to all appointments to the Community Service Board, or its sub-committees, as hereinafter approved.

This local law is offered by the Health, Educational Services Services and Agriculture Committee.
