LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1983

A LOCAL LAW ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR
DIRECTOR OF REAL PROPERTY TAX SERVICES II,
EMERGENCY SERVICES COORDINATOR, COMMISSIONER
OF SOCIAL SERVICES GROUP I, AND PERSONNEL
OFFICER

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Representatives of the County
of Otsego as follows:

Section 1. The salary for the Director of Real Property
Tax Services II be and hereby is established at the sum of
Twenty-Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$23,600) per annum,
commencing January 1, 1984;

Section 2. The salary for the Emergency Services Coordinator
be and hereby is established at the sum of Fifteen Thousand Eight
Hundred Seventeen Dollars (\$15,817.00) per annum, commencing
January 1, 1984;

Section 3. The salary for the Commissioner of Social
Services Group I be and hereby is established at the sum of
Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) per annum, commencing
January 1, 1984;

Section 4. The salary for the Personnel Officer be and
hereby is established at the sum of Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred
Dollars (\$17,500) per annum, commencing January 1, 1984.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect forty-five
(45) days after it shall have been adopted and certified copies
thereof have been filed as required by Section 27 of the Municipal
Home Rule Law.

RESOLUTION NO. 224**RESOLUTION — PROCLAIMING NOVEMBER 6—12, 1983 CONGREGATE AND HOME DELIVERED MEALS WEEK KINNEY, SCHOONOVER, WADDINGTON**
