

**LOCAL LAW NO. 6 OF 1962
COUNTY OF OTSEGO, NEW YORK**

**A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE IN SALARY
OF THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC WELFARE OF THE
COUNTY OF OTSEGO**

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Otsego as follows:

Section 1. That the salary of the Commissioner of Public Welfare of the County of Otsego shall be \$7,500.00 per year payable in equal monthly installments.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect January 1, 1963.
