Brown's Pharmacy 225 Main Street Unadilla, NY 13849 (607) 369-2131	Scheduled in Phase 2 of vaccine distribution. Expect to receive vaccine in late spring, early summer at earliest. As they get closer to that timeline, they will develop plan for clinics.
Church and Scott Pharmacy 5396 State Hwy 28 Cooperstown, NY 13326 (607) 547-1228	Scheduled in Phase 2 of vaccine distribution. Expect to receive vaccine in late spring, early summer at earliest. As they get closer to that timeline, they will develop plan for clinics.
CVS Pharmacy 95 Beaver Street Cooperstown, NY 13326 (607) 547-8791	Can enroll online at https://www.cvs.com/immunizations/covid-19-vaccine to schedule an appointment. There is no phone number to schedule appointments currently. No local appointments available at this time due to supply.
Hannaford's Pharmacy 705 State Hwy 28 Oneonta, NY 13820 (607) 432-0012	Scheduled in Phase 2 of vaccine distribution. Expect to receive vaccine in late spring, early summer at earliest. Have plan in place and ready to implement once vaccine is received.
Kinney Drugs 10 Main Street Richfield Springs, NY 13439 (315) 858-3229	Can enroll online at https://www.kinneydrugs.com/pharmacy/covid-19/vaccination-scheduling/ny/ . For those without computer access, can call (315) 858-3229 and press option 7. Attendant will ask for name and check to see if any appointments are available at local pharmacies. Can also sign up for text alerts by texting "COVID" to 51094 and receive a text when appointments are available at local pharmacy. 2 nd vaccine appointment will be scheduled once 1 st vaccine shot is received.

<p>Rite Aid 400 Chestnut Street Oneonta, NY 13820 (607) 432-3200</p> <p>94 Chestnut Street Oneonta, NY 13820 (607) 432-7640</p>	<p>Although Rite Aid previously had an online link for scheduling vaccine appointments, they have since transitioned to requiring people to schedule through NYS by going online to https://covid19vaccine.health.ny.gov/ or by calling (833) 697-4829 to schedule an appointment.</p> <p>400 Chestnut Street location was maintaining a list of 65+ that called the pharmacy directly, but they are no longer taking names as 500 are already signed up. 94 Chestnut Street location has not received any vaccine to date.</p>

They open up their website typically late afternoon on Mondays or early Tuesday morning to schedule appointments for Friday, Saturday and Sundays that week. Must create an online account to sign up and must use a unique email address. They have set up a phone number to schedule appointments (800) 925-4733 but have had issues up to this point.</p> <p>* When you enroll online, you can't schedule appointment for 1st vaccine only. It will only let you schedule if appointments are available for both the 1st and 2nd vaccine. You will receive this message online "Please come back later to schedule your Dose 1 and Dose 2 appointments. We don't have enough timeslots available to book both of your appointments."</p> <p>They are not wait listing, nor can staff at the local pharmacy make appointments for anyone.</p>
