INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT)- BRIAN POKORNY

Brian Pokorny, Director of IT, discussed the following considerations and overall departmental priorities, including but not limited to:

- IT supports all County departments, however spends much of the time on three departments: Social Services, Public Safety/ Sheriff's department, and 911 Communications
- investments during the past 3 years include data back-up and cybersecurity upgrades
- new in 2020: MUNIS software roll out: Phase I- financials, Phase II- payroll, Phase III- tax collection, and Phase IV- asset management (inventory); additional modules available for purchase at a future date should the County elect to expand the use of the software
- Mr. Pokorny said he would like to see additional funding for IT department staff to be on-call to handle emergencies

The Committee declared a break at 10:42 am, and reconvened at 10:51am.

Mr. Pokorny continued the discussion, including but not limited to:

- the contract for purchasing services is continuing with Onondaga County through MUNIS transition
- new in 20202: County-wide system upgrade for a new phone system for department by department roll out
